









You can select up to 5 pharmacies including Mail Order. Most Drug Plans provide benefits at nearly all pharmacies. However, each pharmacy may charge more or less than another pharmacy. Prices between stores in large chains or Kaiser are the same. Choose a Kaiser outpatient clinic for a Kaiser pharmacy to avoid Hospital pricing.











This HICAP chart of 5 Generic Drugs often used by *Consumers Reports* shows the large difference between 3 plans when you include **all costs** for prescription drugs for 1 year. Preferred Pharmacy is also very important as you can see when Pharmacy Y has higher prices and Pharmacy Z is not in the Plan and charges full retail price!
